NOTIFICATION.

The 21st May 1878.—It is hereby notified for general information that the Lieutenant-Governor has been pleased, in the exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 8 of the Bengal Municipal Act, 1876, to extend to the Union of Mooktagacha, in the district of Mymensingh, the provisions of Chapters I, II, and V of the Act, with effect from the 1st July 1878, and to declare that for the purposes of this Act, it shall be deemed to be a Second Class Municipality from the aforesaid date.

2. The Lieutenant-Governor is also pleased to direct that the following shall be the boundaries of the Municipality :—

On the North, the Aeman River.

On the West, the western limits of Luksmikholla.

On the South, the southern limits of Iswargáon, Nandibári, and Kukurmára.

On the East, the eastern limits of Kowandángá, Káthgára, and Párátangí.

- 1. Mooktagacha with its three bazars.
- 2. Luksmikholla.
- 3. Kowandángá.
- 4. Káthgára.

- 5. Párátangí.
- 6. Iswargáon.
- 7. Nándibári.
- 8. Kukurmára.

The Municipality will include the villages named in the margin, situated in the outpost of Mooktagacha, within the police station of Kotwali.

3. Under Section 77 of the Act it is further notified that the tax to be levied within the Municipality shall be a tax upon persons occupying holdings within the Municipality according to their circumstances and property within the Municipality.

4. Under Sections 15 and 17 of the Act the following gentlemen are appointed to be Commissioners of the Municipality :—

- 1. The Joint-Magistrate of Mymensingh for the time being, *ex-officio*.
- 2. Baboo Surya Kunta Acharjya Chowdhuri, Rai Bahadoor, Zemindar of Mooktagacha.
- 3. „ Amirta Narain Acharjya Chowdhuri, Zemindar of Mooktagacha.
- 4. „ Jogendra Narain Acharjya Chowdhuri, do. do.
- 5. „ Keshub Chandra Acharjya Chowdhuri, do. do.
- 6. „ Durga Dass Acharjya Chowdhuri, do. do.
- 7. „ Kedar Kishore Acharjya Chowdhuri, do. do.
